Duties:

Psychiatric Evaluation of patients

Development of appropriate treatment plans individualized to the patient needs including judicious use of psychotropic medications, psychotherapy, patient and caregiver education and referral to appropriate specialists or mental health providers when indicated.

Medication management and follow-up

Ongoing consultation and collaboration with other providers and maintaining a multidisciplinary team approach to patient care.

Documentation

Psychotherapy may be provided selectively

Requirements:

Graduate of an accredited Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) program.

Board certification from the ANCC as a PMHNP (non-ANCC board certification in mental health or related field may also be considered depending on certification and mental health experience)

Current licensure as an APNP and RN in the State of Wisconsin

At least 2 years' experience as a PMHNP or mental health provider.

Valid DEA and WI state licensure for prescriptive authority

Malpractice insurance coverage that is in compliance with State of Wisconsin Chapter N8* regulations and clinic coverage amounts.

Confidence and ability to practice independently in a clinic without direct supervision from a physician (references required)

Must have an established, documented relationship with a collaborating physician per State of Wisconsin Chapter N8 regulations regarding independent practice and collaboration with other health professionals
